Susannah states on Oaths that she was residing ^{near} her farm near the Buzzard Roost on Challohoochy near the boundary line between the Creek & Cherokee when the Whites obtained the land and settled the Creek lands. The ~~White~~ citizens of Georgia became so troublesome that Clament was forced to abandon her premises consisting of 2 Dwelling Houses 1 Corn & Acre land at the same time and place the Citizens of Georgia stole from Clament 8 head of Cattle 14 head of hogs, a Table & Bedstead.

Clament further states that when leaving Buzzard Roost she settled at Chisomney or Crawfish. At Crawfish Clament had a Dwelling House Corn crib 50 Fruit Trees & Ten Acres of Clear land Clament was dispossessed of her farm at Crawfish by the oppressive laws of Georgia shortly after they were extended ^{to this country}. She Clament then settled on the Noytown River near the junction Eastanally & Noytown Rivers, and made a improvement as follows 1 Dwelling House 1 Corn Crib 1200 Acres of land. She was residing at the last named place when captured in the Year 1838. Clament further states that when forced off by the U.S. Troops she left 2 horses, and about the same time had a large Hog killed by the White people. All the balance of her property contained in her estate she left when forced off by the Troops in 1838 and has never received any pay for the property charged to U.S.
